Testing Instructions

Registration: Registration is first come, first served. Pre-registration is required.

Confirmation: We will automatically send confirmation to all who include their email.

Refund Policy: Refunds are allowed until two weeks before testing. In the case of illness on the day of testing, your child may be able to make up the test at another time and location.

Envelopes: On the first day of testing, bring a 4x9 1/2 inch size, self-addressed envelope for EACH child being tested, which includes:

Child's name and address on front. Test level (i.e. 6th grade) and coordinators name on the LEFT hand bottom corner on the BACK of the envelope. Child's birthday on the BACK TOP.

Test results will be returned in these envelopes, so please print clearly and DO NOT let your child (ren) do this!

Materials: Bring TWO #2 pencils with erasers and ruler with both metric and standard measurement. High schoolers should bring calculators.

Food: Bring a lunch, beverage and snacks.

Time Fillers: Bring books, magazines or something to do in case your student finishes a subtest early.

NO electronic devices allowed!!

Emergency Phone Number: It is important for us to be able to contact a parent, friend or neighbor in case of illness or other emergency. If your contact number changes by the first day of testing, please let us know.

Safety First: Parents and peers are not allowed on campus after testing children are dropped off. Parents are to pick up children from the fellowship hall after being notified that testing is over. Thank you for your cooperation!

Proctoring: We cannot have testing without help from parents. Each grade has to have a proctor. If you are interested in being a proctor please let me know by writing a note on the bottom of the registration form before you mail it in. A 4 year degree is required. Thanks for considering our needs.

There is a proctor meeting scheduled the Wednesday before testing for training. The meeting time is 1:00. I will contact you to confirm your availability to be a proctor as we approach the testing dates.
