Test Day Instructions 2010

TEST LOCATIONS:

Graham (June 10-11) Graham Emmanuel Baptist 22316 – 106th Ave E Graham

REGISTRATION: Registration is first-come, first-served, so register early.

CONFIRMATION: If you desire confirmation, send a SASE with your registration, or circle your email address on the registration form.

REFUND POLICY: Refunds are allowed until TWO weeks before testing. There will be no refunds for “No Shows”. In the case of illness on the day of testing, I will attempt to provide an opportunity for your child to make up the test at another time and location.

TESTING DAY CHECK-IN: Check-in on Day 1 of testing will begin at 8:30. Your child(ren) will need to be ready for testing to begin promptly at 9:00. On Day 2 of testing, there will be no check-in and your child(ren) will report directly to the testing room. Late students arriving after 9:00 will miss the first test section of the day; we will try to make up any missed tests. For the sake of all the testing students, please arrive on time! **Daily testing will be finished about 1:15 – 1:30pm. High School finishes at 11:30 AM.**

ENVELOPES: On the first day of testing, bring a business size (4x9 1/2), self-addressed stamped** envelope for EACH child being tested, which includes:

1. The child's name and address on the front.
2. The child's testing grade on **left** hand bottom corner of the **back** of envelope.
3. Test coordinator (Jill Burgher) on **right** hand bottom corner of **back** of envelope.
3. Child's birthday on the back top of the envelope. (only if your child does not know month/day/year of birth).
4. **Do not** put a return address label on the envelope.

. Test Results will be returned in these envelopes, so please print clearly and DO NOT let your children do this!!!

MATERIALS: Bring TWO #2 pencils with erasers on both testing days and a ruler with BOTH metric and standard measurement on Day 2. High School students should bring calculators on Day 2.

FOOD: Bring a lunch, beverage, and snacks for each child. NO chewing gum, candy, or soda pop at testing.

TIME FILLERS: Bring books, magazines, or something to do QUIETLY in case your student(s) finish subtests early.

*****NO electronic toys, Gameboys, etc. are allowed!!!*****

EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBER: It is important for us to be able to contact a parent, friend, or neighbor in case of illness or other emergency. This number can be a pager, cell phone, spouse's work, neighbor, or friend who will fill in for you if necessary. IF this contact number changes by the first day of testing, please let us know.

TEST SCORING REPORTS: Test results should be back in early August
